Stillwater Refuge is looking for three men, ages 18-23, who are in love with Jesus, willing to staff a youth camp, and ready to work on a ranch. Would you sacrifice your summer for this life changing opportunity to disciple youth through hunting and fishing?

What is Summer Camp at Stillwater Refuge?

We believe one of the most effective ways to change the world is to call out the next generation of young men to walk in the destiny they were created for. Summer Camp is a seven-day adventure where young men learn how to shoot guns and bows, hunt and process animals, and many other things all while getting real with Jesus.

Job Description:

The Manternship is an eight-week adventure that is comprised of work, Bible study, discipleship and missions. Job descriptions include but are not limited to:

During camp week

- Camp counselor
- Ranch Staff
- Hunting and fishing guide
- Lifeguard
- Instruct animal processing from start to finish
- Demonstrate proper firearm safety
- Teach various hunting techniques
- Supervise in cooking, cleaning and chores
- Referee paintball

During non-camp week

- Grounds keeping and maintenance
- Scouting animals
- Maintaining deer feeders and blinds
- Bible Study
- Ranch Staff
- Cooking and Cleaning
- Firearm cleaning and maintenance

- **The Manternship will conclude with a week long mission trip, guided by Stillwater Staff, outside of the United States.**

Requirements:

- Must become a certified lifeguard by the beginning of the program
- Must be between the ages of 18-23
- Must have current Passport before beginning of the program
- Must be Hunter Safety Certified by the beginning of the program
- Must raise your own support (approx. \$5,000)
